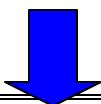

MONDAY, July 12th, 09:30 – 16:30

Tour to Oceanarium & “Parque das Nações” (former Expo Grounds)

Leaving the Conference Centre, enjoy a panoramic tour of Lisbon through the city center. Continue east to “Parque das Nações”. Upon arrival at this former Expo ground, board a cable car for a fantastic overview of this area of the city and the river.

Then follows a visit to the Oceanarium.

It is the mission of the Lisbon Oceanarium to contribute toward global conservation by entertaining, inspiring and educating through bringing people into intimate and emotional contact with the marine environment and its inhabitants.

Inhabited by 15,000 animals and plants representing over 450 different species, the Lisbon Oceanarium is constituted by 30 tanks that hold around 7 million litres of seawater!

Buffet lunch at the terrace of the state of the art “Vasco da Gama” shopping centre.

After lunch free time to wander around the “Parque das Nações” or shopping.

Return to the Conference Centre.

Price: Euro 95 per person

TUESDAY, July 13th, 09:00 – 18:00

Tour to Évora

Departure from the Congress Centre by private bus, in direction to the South across the World's largest cork region for an exciting journey into the past to Évora, classified as "Museum Town and World Heritage" by the Unesco in 1986.

Évora during the Medieval times held together with Lisbon the courts of the Portuguese Kings from 1165 to 1559.

Visit the Roman-Gothic cathedral dating from 1186, the church of St. Francis built in 1840 with the macabre Chapel of Bones, the ruins of the Roman Temple of Diana are some other places of great interest.

Lunch at a local restaurant.

Return to Lisbon and to the congress centre.

Price: Euro 86,00 per person

Ticket includes coach, English speaking tourguide throughout the entire tour, admission fee to the cathedral and to the Saint Francis Church and two course lunch with drinks. Minimum number of participants: 15

WEDNESDAY, July 14th, 09:30 – 12:30 Artistic Lisbon

Departure from the Conference Centre by private bus to the east part of the city for a visit to the The National Tile Museum.

The National Tile Museum is located in the Convent of Madre de Deus, which dates from 1509. From its original structure only the lower floor cloister and the Arab room remain today. The church is covered with rich ornamental Baroque works of paintings, carving and tiles offered by royal patronage.

The collection, which virtually depicts the entire history of the tile in Portugal, includes tiles dating from the second half of the 15th century to contemporary artefacts already using new technologies. The highlights are the mannerist retable of Nossa Senhora da Vida and the Lisbon panel, 23 metres long, representing Lisbon before the 1755 earthquake.

Return to the Congress Centre.
